

**CITY OF GREENDALE
BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS' REGULAR MEETING

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Huddleston called the Board of Alderpersons' Regular Meeting to order at 6:31 P.M.

The members present constituted a quorum. Also present were Bill Hanks (City Clerk), Tasha Van Norman (Clerk), and Lieutenant Jeff Ballard of the Normandy Police Department.

Aldersperson Herman was medically excused from the meeting.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

Mayor Huddleston asked for the approval for Bill 711/Ordinance 701 – Municipal Judge Appointment (Felica A. Ezell) to be moved up on the agenda. The Board had a no objection to Mayor Huddleston request.

ORDINANCE 701 – FELICA A. EZELL MUNICIPAL JUDGE APPOINTMENT

Aldersperson Trojcak introduced Bill 711/Ordinance 701 – Municipal Judge Appointment (Felica A. Ezell) and referred to Mayor Huddleston for its first reading by title only. Mayor Huddleston read Bill 711/Ordinance 701 – Municipal Judge Appointment (Felica A. Ezell) for the first time by title only. A motion was made by Aldersperson Trojcak, seconded by Aldersperson Ringo, to accept the first reading by title only. A roll call vote was taken with Alderspersons Garhart, Ringo, and Trojcak voting aye. **Motion passed.**

REPORTS

Normandy Police: Lieutenant Jeff Ballard read the submitted written report to the Board, and gave a verbal report of activities in Greendale for March 21, 2017 through April 21, 2017. There were 47 calls for service, 6 traffic citations and 3 police reports taken. Mayor Huddleston asked Lieutenant Ballard about the whereabouts of some police radios that possibly belongs to the City of Greendale. Lieutenant Ballard stated that the Police Chief and Major will look into this matter and he will get an answer back for the Board. A brief discussion about patrolling and community engagement took place.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer David Ruth was not present at this time

Committee Reports: Ms. Burroughs stated that the Emergency Management Committee has slowed down, but the committee is planning to meet on April 19, 2017.

Julie Dunn-Morton the Forestry Advisory Committee met on April 12, 2017, to discuss the Arbor Day celebration and City owned property ground maintenance. Ms. Dunn Morton asked the City Clerk to send out an email blast to remind the residents about the Arbor Day celebration at the Park on April 30, 2017. There is no committee meeting scheduled at this time. The Forestry Advisory Committee's members provided 42.75 hours of volunteer service during the month of March (The Forestry Advisory Committee report is attached).

Alderperson Garhart talked about the different types of criterion for the sidewalk slab replacement survey and municipal league training she recently attended.

Alderperson Trojcak discussed her involvement with Proposition N, which passed in the April Municipal Election (Alderperson Trojcak Report is attached).

MAYOR COMMENTS

Mayor Huddleston told the Board about a couple upcoming training opportunities for elected officials and a couple legislative bills that are currently under consideration by the state.

Alderman Trojcek asked for an update and some sort of timeline for 2210 Normandy Drive. Mayor Huddleston stated that they are still working on finalizing the plans. A brief discussion about bids, estimates, utilities bills, and insurance for 2210 Normandy Drive took place.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Jackie Payton, 2529 Leadale:

- She wanted to know the status of the last judge that was appointed by the Board
- She asked about Alderman Herman.

Mayor Huddleston stated that the last judge was appointed to another position by the Governor of Missouri and could no longer be our judge. Also, he told everyone that Alderman Herman is currently recovering nicely from a procedure.

Stephanie Walker, 7441 Marillac:

- She asked about the date for the citywide garage sale, which is sometime in June.
