NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Publication Date: June 9, 2017

The City of Greendale will hold a public hearing to discuss the estimated allocation of **\$20,000.00** in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds which will become available after January 1, 2018, the reallocation of \$4,200 in CDBG funds which are currently available from year 2015 and reallocation of 20,000 in CDBG funds which will be available some time in 2017. The public hearing will be held at **6:30 pm on Tuesday, June 20, 2017, at Incarnate Word Academy Cafeteria, 2788 Normandy Drive, St. Louis, MO 63121.**

To further its commitment to fair and equitable treatment of all citizens, the City of Greendale has enacted and/or enforces the following:

A Fair Housing Ordinance prohibiting unlawful discrimination against any person because of race, sex, color, religion, disability, familial status or national origin;

SUMMER READING PROGRAMS GALORE! Area youth and adults can take advantage of the great summer reading clubs and programs at the St Louis County Library Natural Bridge branch. In addition, the Natural Bridge branch will be serving free lunch daily from noon to 1 pm for youth age 18 and younger. There are other branches offering lunch as well, but the Natural Bridge branch is closest to Greendale. Youth can read books at the library, or check them out to read at home. Every child should read at least 20 minutes every day, or have a parent or other family member read to him/her if he/she does not know how to read yet.

Also, Half Price Books on McKnight at Delmar in University City, in the old Walgreens location, has a Feed Your Brain summer reading program. During June and July, youth aged 14 or younger, or 8th grade and younger can earn Bookworm Bucks to purchase books, music, movies and games just for reading at least 15 minutes per day and noting same on a log sheet. The log sheet must then be signed by the parent or guardian. Once the child has reached the minimum 300 minutes of reading, the signed form can be turned in at the store. Grownups can read aloud to kids who are still learning. Visit HPB.com/FYB to download a reading log and get started! All awards must be cashed in and used by August 31st.
