BOARD OF ALDERPERSONS REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Meeting Held via Teleconference on June 15, 2021

Due to current Coronavirus precautions and social distancing guidelines, meetings are being conducted via teleconference.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Graham called the meeting to order at 6:36 PM

ROLL CALL

Mayor Tiffany Graham, City Administrator Jackie Payton, Ald. Monica Jefferson, Ald. Jane Kayser, Alderperson Deborah Shackelford, Code Enforcement Officer Bryant Goston, City Attorney Phil Ayers, and Normandy Police Officer Tameka Sanders were all present on the call. Treasurer Tiffany Walker was excused.

NO ADDITIONS OR SUBTRACTIONS TO THE AGENDA

PUBLIC COMMENT

Resident Julie Dunn-Morton informed that the Forestry Advisory Committee will be meeting Thursday June 17th at 6:30pm at the park pavilion.

NO MAYOR'S COMMENTS

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

It was moved by Ald. Jefferson and seconded by Ald. Kayser to approve the minutes from the May 18, 2021 Board of Alderpersons meeting. Ald. Jefferson voted yes. Voting paused due to technical difficulties.

REPORTS

Officer Tameka Sanders of Normandy PD reported 23 calls for service with 0 reports being taken. Officer Sanders informed that they were still monitoring the nuisance property on Leadale (0 service calls this month), and that maintenance resources were extended to that resident. Ald. Kayser inquired about speeding on St. Charles Rock Rd; was informed it is not Normandy's jurisdiction, but they can try to place officer nearby as a deterrent.

Code Enforcement Officer Bryant Goston reported that he is currently working on the annual exterior surveys. Attorney Ayers inquired about the filing of court cases; agreed to meet to go over processes.

City Attorney Phil Ayers reported that the presiding judge of St. Louis County Circuit Courts has approved in-person appearances, explained the memo and that we still await Normandy's decision to resume. Attorney Ayer informed that a prosecutor's assistant has been hired at the courts and expressed concern over case backlog.

For Normandy Schools Collaborative, Ald. Kayser reported that construction has begun at the high school, grab and meals were still being offered from 11am-2pm Mon, Wed, Fri at Lucas Crossing school, and that the board meetings will now be held on the 2nd Monday of every month (formerly 2nd Tues).
