FEMA TRAINING

City Administrator Payton provided the specifics of how the current alderperson/ mayoral terms are/were filled, when they expire, and which ones will be up for vote in April of 2022. Concern was expressed over the possibly of still being one alderperson short.

ELECTION FILING INFORMATION




LEAF-VAC
