FREE Community Emergency Response Team Training

Have you ever thought, “What would I do if a tornado struck my subdivision?” or “What types of natural disasters can happen in St. Louis?” We have the answers! Community Emergency Response Team Training (CERT) is a series of classes that prepares you to help yourself, family, co-workers and neighbors in the event of a crisis in your community. Through this interesting eight-week series of classes, participants learn about emergency preparedness and receive training in basic



response skills such as fire safety, team organization, terrorism, disaster psychology, disaster preparedness, light search and rescue and disaster medical operations. Through a partnership with local emergency responders who are trained professionals and CERT trainers, you will learn life-saving skills! Once the eight classes are

completed, training will conclude with a full-scale disaster exercise (off-site) that will put what you have learned to work in a real-life tornado simulation. Upon successful completion of the training you will be able to join a local St. Louis area CERT program to continue to support and help in times where volunteers are needed. 2019 - 2020 Animal License Registration

Licensing of dogs and cats in Greendale is required annually by May 1st (Ordinance 205.020). The fee for registration is \$5.00 per pet and a copy of your pet's rabies vaccination is required. Failure to register will result in a citation from code enforcement. **LETTERS WILL BE GOING OUT SOON TO PET OWNERS THAT HAVE FAILED TO REGISTER THIS YEAR.** Registration forms can be found on our website or you may come into city hall to complete the registration in person.
