## Greendale/St. Louis County Inspection & Permit Process

Moving and home improvement season won't be for a few months, but in case you're thinking of transfer of ownership or occupancy, or adding a fence or wall, or any other renovations or add-ons, [please check with City Hall to see if you will need an inspection or permit prior to proceeding.](#)

The general procedure for Residential permits are as follows:

1. Resident completes Residential Occupancy Permit Application at Greendale City Hall.
2. Resident contacts St. Louis County to arrange building inspection. Greendale does an exterior inspection.
3. St. Louis County sends Greendale City Hall the Occupancy Certificate.
4. Greendale then issues the Occupancy Permit to resident.

### At Home

- Lock all doors and windows before leaving home.

- When you shop online, be sure the web address starts with "https." That extra "s" stands for secure, and it proves the website encrypts the sensitive data like your payment info.
- Don't shop on a public network, like at a coffee shop or in an airport.
