NSC RECEIVES HONOR FROM STLCC

With 3,100 students enrolled, Normandy Schools Collaborative (NSC) is the school district that serves Greendale, and the other communities in the 24:1. Under the leadership of Dr. Charles Pearson, Superintendent of Schools for Normandy, NSC was honored on Jan. 21 with the 2020 Dr. Rance Thomas Excellence in Community Partnership Award for its collaboration with STLCC on the Early College programs.

“NSC was chosen to receive the award...because of their commitment to student success and opportunity,” said Dr. Elizabeth Gassel Perkins, campus president and chief academic officer at STLCC-Florissant Valley. “Florissant Valley’s first early college academy graduates came from Normandy, and they have consistently sent 20 or more students each year to participate in our dual enrollment programs,” she said.

Appreciative, Dr. Pearson said, “First, we are honored to receive the award named for such an influential and vital person in our community. Secondly, the partnership with St. Louis Community College has helped so many of our students start their careers on the right track. We’re humbled and extremely grateful for the recognition.”

Normandie 1901 LLC Relinquishes Normandie Golf Course Lease



Walters Golf Management has notified the University of Missouri – St. Louis that it is exercising an option to opt out of its lease of the Normandie Golf Course – effective in late March 2020.

UMSL purchased the historic course and agreed to a \$1-per-year lease with Walters to help ensure Normandie was maintained and operated in a way to benefit students and the surrounding communities, and they say that remains their top priority.

They have requested that the University of Missouri System Real Estate Management Office create and distribute a request for

proposal as quickly as possible – with a goal of leasing the course to another management firm this spring.

Interim Chancellor Kristin Sobolik says that she is also in conversations with other potential public and private partners about a multi-faceted proposal that would ensure the long-term viability and improvement of Normandie as well as the enhancement of other nearby sites and will continue to keep the community informed as any plans progress.

Greendale’s TRIM Grant Application Gets Approved

Good News! The Forestry Advisory Committee is happy to announce that the Tree Resource Improvement and Management (TRIM) grant application we submitted in June 2019 was approved by the Missouri Department of Conservation. As a Tree City USA, we qualify for a 75% match and will be reimbursed up to \$8076 toward the projects for which we requested funding. The four projects include planting street trees, removal of dead and dying trees, pruning to improve the structure of trees, and a tree care workshop for residents.

Fourteen trees of five species, all native to Missouri, were planted throughout the city on Wednesday, January 8. The trees were grown by Forest ReLeaf of Missouri and provided to Greendale at no cost through their Priority ReLeaf program. We want to express our thanks and appreciation to Forest ReLeaf for the trees and to the Missouri Department of Conservation for sponsoring the TRIM grant program. We also thank the Greendale residents who help by watering our young trees.
